In my capacity as acting Trefnydd, I am notifying all members of a correction to the record pertaining to the plenary business questions on 5 March 2024. This correction is in response to a question from Darren Millar MS, who requested an update on the Welsh Government's Workplace Recycling Regulations.

It was Welsh Government officials and a representative from Natural Resources Wales (NRW) who met industry on the 7 March 2024, and not the Minister for Climate Change Julie James MS, as I originally stated. This meeting was convened by the Welsh Retail Consortium (WRC) and attended by WRC members to answer questions from retailers on the regulations. The meeting is a recent example of a comprehensive programme of engagement and awareness raising to ensure readiness, which includes the provision of sector specific information, webinars and guides, alongside a national communications campaign that includes TV, radio and billboard adverts and direct mail letters.
