Thank you for your recent Written Question asking what assessment have I made of the cost to the Welsh Government of matching the UK Government's pay offer for NHS consultants in England of a £3,000 consolidated payment and a 6 per cent pay increase, compared with the Welsh Government's current offer of a 5 per cent increase.

The recent offer to NHS consultants in England is not a straightforward £3,000 payment, it is a restructure of the consultants pay scale. Please see the full offer in detail <u>Fixing pay for consultants in England (bma.org.uk)</u>

No tangible information is provided regarding how the NHS pay offer for consultants in England will be funded and the UK Government has repeatedly failed to provide details about the consequential funding early enough in the budget process to be reflected in pay offers we make to staff.
